| Program Description | A 15 month long program aimed at developing young Jewish leadership along with a commitment to social justice; includes regional retreats and Shabbatonim along with hosting Israeli teens as part of the Boston Haifa partnership. Diller Fellows travel to Israel for 3 weeks in the summer of 2019 joining with Diller fellows from across the U.S. | Leadership training and Israel advocacy, seminars and community service along with touring | In a program modeled on inclusion and leadership training, typically developing teens and Yachad members (teens and young adults with special needs) travel together through Israel. | Travel throughout Israel and receive Israel advocacy training throughout. |
| Add'l Comments | This program has become highly competitive. Interested applicants should also bear in mind the long term time commitment it requires. | | The program begins with an orientation in upstate NY where participating high school students receive background and preparation for interacting with Yachad members. Orientation is followed by a Shabbaton in New Jersey with the Yachad members who will also be travelling to Israel. | The program is comprised largely of North Shore area teens. Attendance at pre and post trip meetings as well as some writing is required. |
