Honoree: Praised be the One, to Whom our praise is due! Congregation: Praised be the One, to Whom our praise is due, now and forever. Honoree repeats: Praised be the One, to Whom our praise is due, now and forever. Honoree continues: Praised is Adonai our God, Ruler of the universe, Who has chosen us from all peoples by giving us this Torah. Praised is Adonai, Giver of the Torah.

Blessing after reading Torah.
